Ephesians 2:19 - So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God.

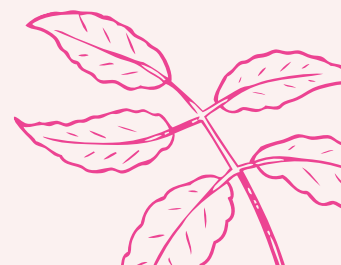
Ephesians 2:6 - And raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus.
